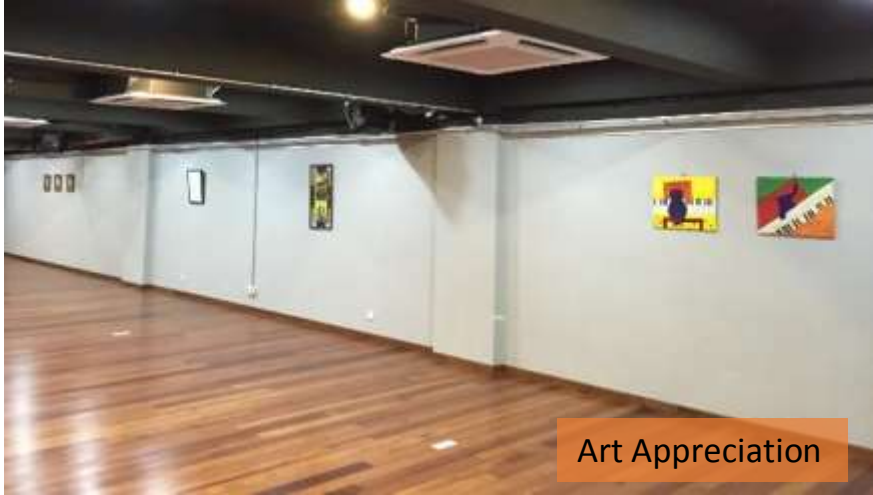

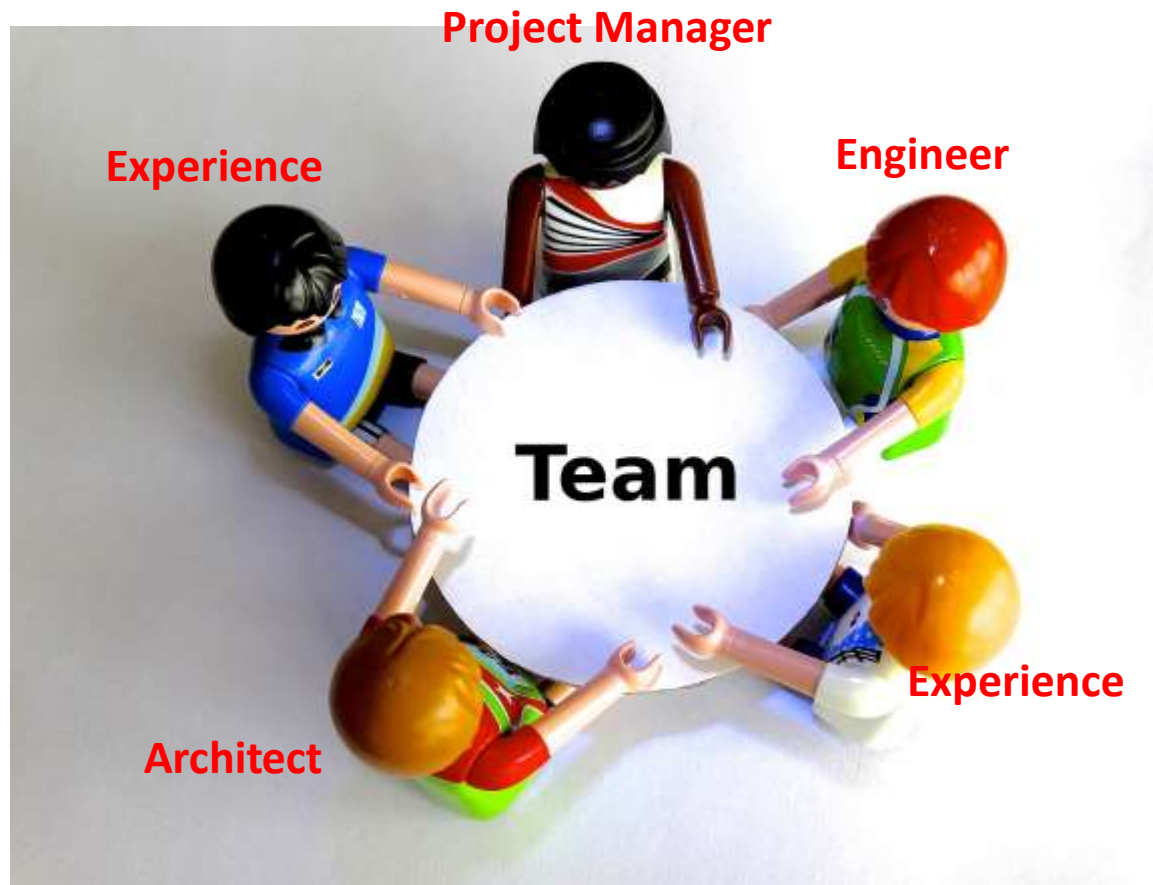

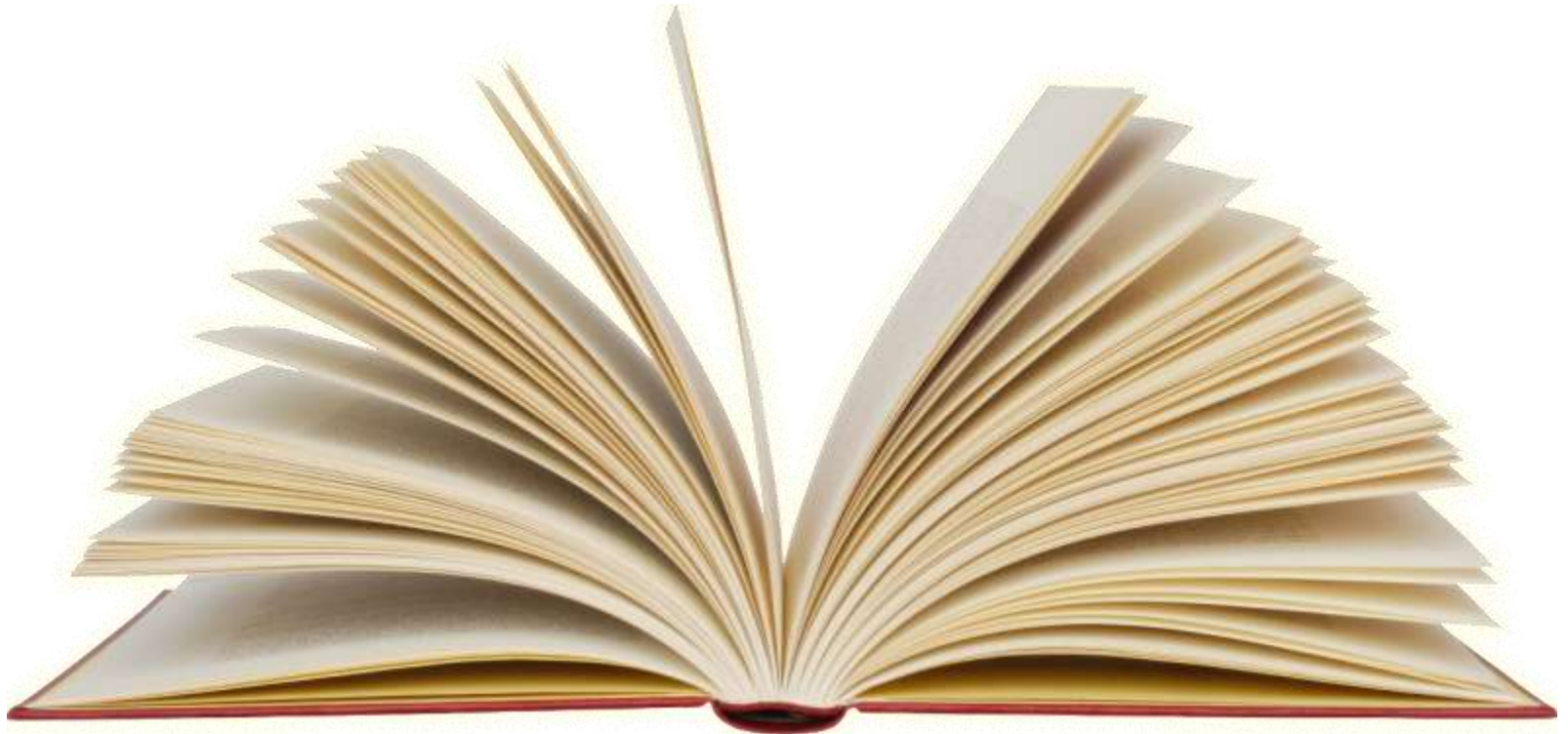
THE DYING TRADES
